cat sitting checklist

Please have the below listed items ready for Michelle. Thank You!

Please have ready for the consult:

- All emergency contact and veterinarian information
- A set of keys that have been tested and labeled with your cat's name.

Please leave out:

- Food and treats.
- Broom.
- Dust pan.
- Extra cat litter.
- Cleaner that you prefer to be used in case of accidents.
- Toys.
- If your cat eats wet food, a fork or spoon that you prefer to be used.
- Cat carrier in an easily accessible place.
- Medications.

Things to keep in mind:

- pet city sitters does not provide dog sitting in homes where there is a third party residing, or coming and going. (roommates, family members, trades people etc.)
- If you are going away for an extended period of time or you are leaving the country, please let your vet know that Michelle will be caring for your cats.
- If you are going to be out of the country or may be unreachable by phone, please consider creating a simple document that gives a relative or friend decision making power in case of medical emergency. You can also have this on file at your vet.
- Please let any neighbors who look out for you or your property know that Michelle will be going into your home each day.
- If it is summer please make sure that there is ONE cool zone in your home. PCS requires at least one window air conditioner or several windows that are allowed to be left open at all times with at least one fan. Window air conditioners are a better choice for purposes of security and possible bad weather.
- If it is cold enough for the heat to be on, please leave your thermostat set within 5 degrees of the temperature that you keep it on when you are home.
- Please let Michelle know if you would like any lights left on.
- Please check all batteries in smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.
